PART 1

PARKS

§16-101. Definitions.

As used in this Part, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated, unless a different meaning clearly appears from the context.

PARK or PARKS — unless specifically limited, shall be deemed to include all parks, playgrounds, recreation areas, tennis courts, recreation structures and facilities, and also entrances and approaches thereto, and all other land or property or structures now or hereafter owned or acquired by the Borough of Coplay for park or recreational purposes.

PERSON — any natural person, corporation, organization of persons, company, association or partnership.

POLICIES — any policies hereby or hereafter promulgated by the Borough Council under the authority herein conferred.

TOT LOT — a park or playground for children up to age ten.

§16-102. Park Hours.

All parks shall be opened daily to the public at such hours as the Borough Council may from time to time designate, but in no event shall any person be permitted to be in attendance in any park between 9:00 p.m. and sunrise, with the exception of the Tot Lot, which will close at 7:00 p.m. unless a child is accompanied by a parent or guardian at which time the closing time will be dusk, and the pavilion area, which will close at 10:00 p.m., unless special permission is granted by Borough Council.

§16-103. Park Policies.

The Borough Council shall adopt, from time to time, policies, including any rules or regulations deemed appropriate by Borough Council, which policies shall regulate all conduct within the park(s). It shall be the duty of any person(s) in attendance at any park to know and to abide by such policies. A written copy of the policies shall be kept on file at the Borough Hall and made available to any person(s) requesting the same.

§16-104. Enforcement.

The police officers of the Borough are charged with enforcement of the provisions of this Part and of the policies promulgated by the Borough Council pursuant to §16-103.

§16-105. Penalties.

Any person, firm or corporation who violates any provision of this Part, or any of the policies promulgated by Borough Council, shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$500 and/or imprisonment for a term not to exceed 90 days.

MUNICIPAL SWIMMING POOL

§16-201. Definitions.

As used in this Part, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated, unless a different meaning clearly appears from the context.

MUNICIPAL SWIMMING POOL — Unless specifically limited, shall be deemed to include the municipal swimming pool and bathhouse facilities, and also entrances and approaches thereto, and all other land or property or structures now or hereafter owned or acquired by the Borough of Coplay for swimming pool purposes.

PERSON — Any natural person, corporation, organization of persons, company, association or partnership.

RULES AND REGULATIONS — Any rules and regulations hereby or hereafter promulgated by the Borough Council under the authority herein conferred.

§16-202. Pool Hours.

The municipal swimming pool shall be opened daily from June to August to the public from 12:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. or 8:00 p.m. or such hours as the Borough Council may from time to time designate, but in no event shall any person be permitted to be in attendance between 9:00 p.m. and sunrise, unless special permission is granted by Borough Council.

§16-203. Pool Policies.

The Borough Council shall adopt, from time to time, policies, including any rules or regulations deemed appropriate by Borough Council, which policies shall regulate all conduct within the pool. It shall be the duty of any person(s) in attendance at the pool to know and to abide by such policies. A written copy of the policies shall be kept on file at the Borough Hall and made available to any person(s) requesting the same.
